Instructions for Putting On and Taking Off a Mask

General Guidelines

- Wearing a mask can help to prevent the spread of some respiratory illnesses, but it can also become a source of infection if not worn or discarded properly.
- **DO NOT** touch a mask while wearing it; **DO NOT** leave a mask around your neck, hanging from your ear, or on your forehead; **DO NOT** store masks in your pocket, **DO NOT** share your mask with others.
- ALWAYS clean your hands with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer:
 - o Before putting on a mask
 - Frequently while wearing a mask
 - o If you accidentally touch your mask
 - After taking it off
